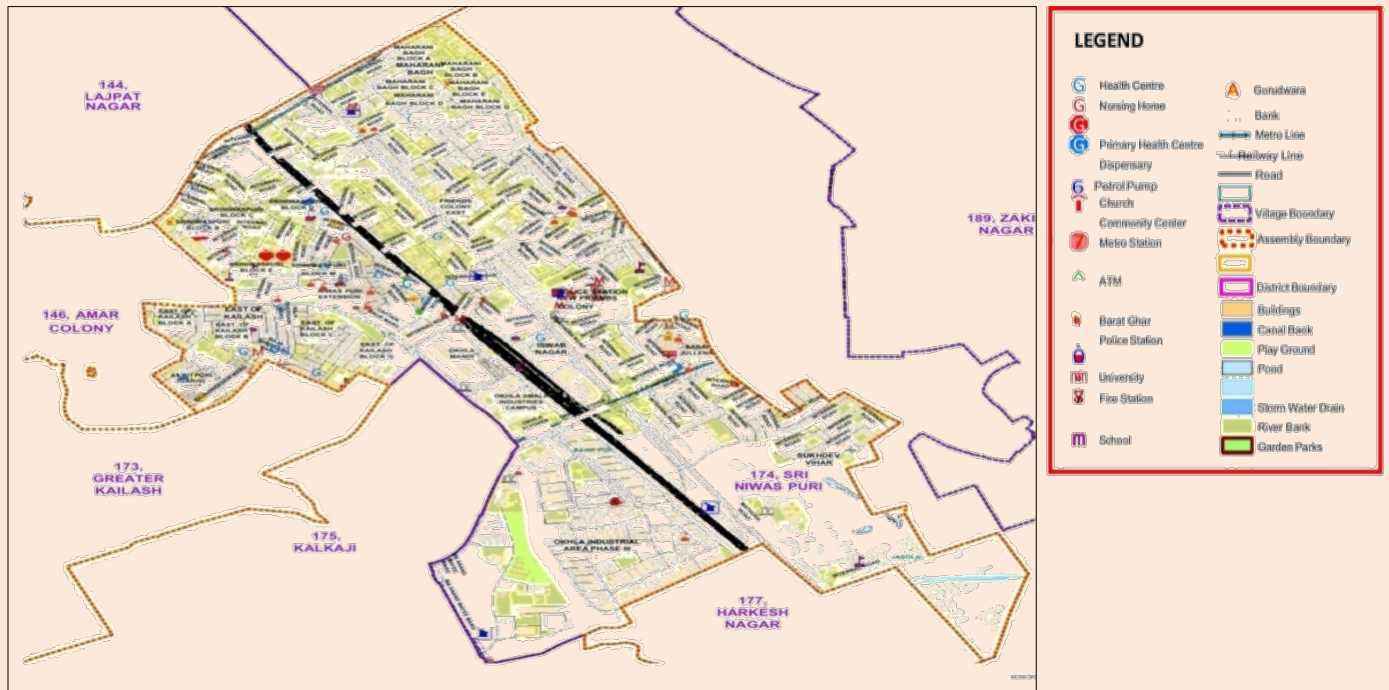

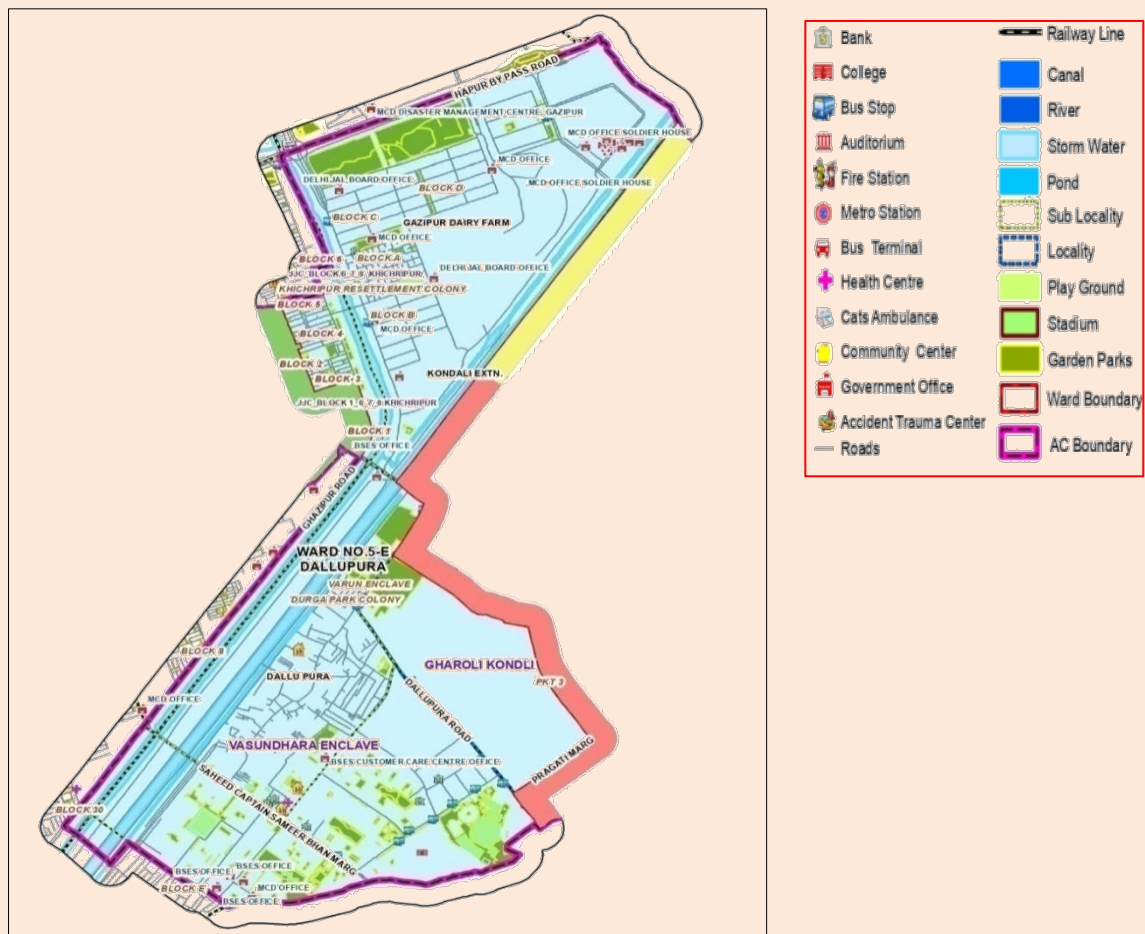

**Description:** The Do Better Foundation's Education Program has expanded its reach, now serving underprivileged children in two Delhi locations: Sri Niwas Puri and Dallupura. Building on last year's success in Sri Niwas Puri, we extended our services to Dallupura, increasing our impact and outreach.

Our education program is designed to bridge the educational gap for underprivileged children, offering:

- Free tuition and academic support
- Comprehensive study materials, including textbooks, notebooks, and stationery
- Mentorship and guidance from experienced teachers and role models
- Regular assessments and feedback to ensure academic progress
- Support for extracurricular activities, such as sports, arts, and cultural events



We believe that every child deserves access to quality education, regardless of their socio-economic background. Our education program aims to create a supportive learning environment, fostering academic excellence, creativity and character development

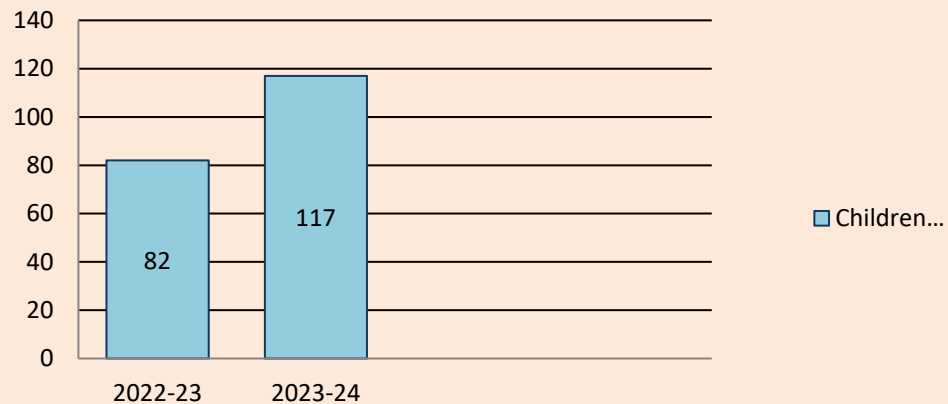

**Objective** Empower women with skills for economic independence, enhancing their employability and self-sufficiency.

**Description** "In FY 2023-24, we launched our Vocational Training Program in Dallupura, offering Certificate courses in Cutting and Stitching and Beauty Culture for women. our program equips ladies with practical skills, promoting financial independence and self-sufficiency. We are committed to empowering women in our community through vocational training program equips women with practical skills in two core areas:

1. **Beauty Culture:** Comprehensive training in beauty services, including hairstyling, makeup, skincare, and nail art.



2. **Cutting and Stitching:** Expertise in garment construction, alteration, and tailoring, with a focus on contemporary fashion trends.





## Program Overview

Our vocational training program is designed to provide women with the skills and confidence needed to succeed in the workforce or establish their own businesses. The program consists of:

- Hands-on training, under the guidance of experienced instructors.
- Mentorship and support, to ensure participants receive personalized attention and guidance.

**Cutting and Stitching :-** 53 candidates participated in this Course

# Health & Awareness Program

## Free Health Camps

A Collaborative Initiative In FY 2023-24, Do Better Foundation, in partnership with Don Bosco NGO and Sampark Sathi Foundation NGO, organized free health camps in the slums of Dallupura and Sri Niwas Puri. This collaborative initiative aimed to provide quality healthcare services to marginalized communities.



### The objective of Free Health Camps :

1. Provide free medical consultations to residents of Dallupura and Sri Niwas Puri slums.
2. Promote health awareness on preventive care, nutrition, and hygiene.

### Implementation

Our free health camps were held once a month, alternating months between Don Bosco NGO and Sampark Sathi Foundation NGO. Their support enabled us to:

- Leverage each other's expertise and resources.
- Expand our reach and impact.
- Foster a sense of community and collaboration.



## **Impact**

Through our Free Health Camps, we:

1. Treated 500+ patients, providing them with timely medical attention and care.
2. Conducted 12 health awareness sessions, empowering community members to take charge of their health.

# Awareness Camps

## Save Environment

Do Better Foundation, conducted an Awareness Camp on Save Environment, aiming to educate and sensitize community members on environmental conservation.

The objective of the camp was to:

1. Educate beneficiaries on the importance of environmental conservation.
2. Promote eco-friendly practices and sustainable living.

## Methodology

The awareness camp was conducted with the participation of our beneficiaries, who played a crucial role in spreading awareness among community members. The camp included:

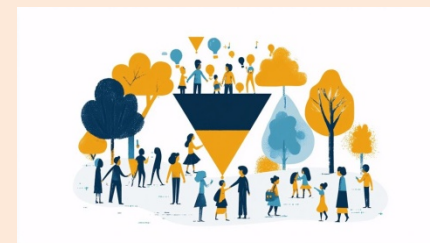
